

# CINEMA AVENTURE (1)

## Galerie du Centre 57, 1000 Bruxelles

#### ARRIVING BY PUBLIC TRANSPORT

Metro 1 + 5 (Stop at De Brouckère - 400 m walk, mostly flat - )

Tram 3 + 4 + 31 + 32 + 33 (Stop at De Brouckère - 400 m walk, mostly flat -)

Stib Bus 29 + 38 + 46 + 47 + 63 + 66 + 71 + 86 + 88 (Stop at De Brouckère - 400 m walk, mostly flat - )

De Lijn Bus 126 + 127 + 128 ( Stop at Brussel Beursschouwburgchouwburg/Bourse - 140 m walk, mostly flat - )

#### ENTERING CINEMA AVENTURE

Cinema Aventure is located inside the Galeries du Centre, the entrance of which is floor-level.

The cinema itself however, (ticket desk, toilets, screenroom) is only accessible by going down a staircase (around 10 steps) and is not equipped with a lift nor a ramp. Once you have passed the ticket desk, a turnstile (tourniquet) scans your ticket before you can enter the main hall, which is relatively limited in space, but has benches to sit on. It is also here that the bar is located.

### FINDING A SEAT IN CINEMA AVENTURE

From the main hall, you will enter the screenroom via a staircase (about 10 steps). A few wider seats without armrest are available at the back of the room in the last row.

### GETTING TO THE TOILETS AT CINEMA AVENTURE

The toilets at Cinema Aventure are not gendered and can be found just before the ticket desk. They are not accessible to people in wheelchairs as they are located at the bottom of the stairs. The toilet stalls open outwards but may be too tight for fat folks (4XL and up).
