

GRANDS CARMES (1)

Rue des Grands Carmes 20/22, 1000 Bruxelles

ARRIVING BY PUBLIC TRANSPORT

Bus 33 + 48 + 95 (Stop at Grand-Place - 240m walk on mostly flat terrain-) or bus 46 (stop at Anneessens - 750 m walk on flat terrain-)

Métro 1+ 5 (Stop at De brouckère - 650 m walk on flat terrain -)

Tram 3+ 4 (Stop at Anneessens - 750 m walk on flat terrain)

ENTERING GRANDS CARMES

The entrance to the Grands Carmes community space is floor level and via a large wooden swing door which leads to a courtyard.

FINDING A SEAT AT THE PERFORMANCE IN GRANDS CARMES

The performance and discussion will take place in the "salle polyvalente" which is only accessible by going up a staircase (about 5 steps). Seating will be composed of chairs, of which some will be without armrests, and a few amrchairs/ couches. A few priority seats will be made available on the first and last row for people with special needs.

GETTING TO THE BAR AND TOILETS AT GRANDS CARMES

The toilets at Grands Carmes are not gendered. They are located in the courtyard and are only accessible by going down 5 steps.

The toilet stalls are relatively wide and should be able to accommodate fat folks sized 4XL and up.

Grands Carmes has two bars: one in the courtyard (which will be closed) and one inside.

The inside bar is accessible via the courtyard and the entrance is at floor level. Both the courtyard and the inside bar are equipped with different types of seating in order to accommodate different needs.

ATTENDING THE PERFORMANCE AND DISCUSSION AT GRANDS CARMES AS A DEAF- OR HEARING IMPAIRED PERSON

The performance and discussion will be in French. Subtitles will unfortunately not be available and there will be no sign language interpreter. The performance will take place without microphones, but for the discussion there will be a microphone available.

A few priority seats will be made available on the first and last row for people with special needs (such as people with hearing disabilities).

ATTENDING THE PERFORMANCE AND DISCUSSION AT GRANDS CARMES AS A NEUROATYPICAL Grands Carmes community centre is equipped with a spacious courtyard and an inside bar, both of which will be separate from the room where the performance will take place. Both spaces are equipped with different types of seating in order to accommodate different needs.
